**Summary of Project**     Rebuild Hackleburg Blitz Build of 4-5 homes

Rebuild Hackleburg Blitz Build is an opportunity to partner with Habitat For Humanity of Marion County to provide decent, affordable housing to impacted families from the April 27<sup>th</sup> Tornado that devastated Hackleburg and destroyed or damaged over 300 homes in the area. The purpose for this build is so that people don't lose hope that the area will be rebuilt by constructing four-five homes simultaneously in a period of two weeks beginning July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

Habitat For Humanity of Marion County is a non-profit Christian housing program with a mission to eliminate substandard housing and promote homeownership for low-income families. Serving Marion County since 2001, 7 homes have been built and the 8<sup>th</sup> is under construction. Houses are sold at cost to qualifying families through interest-free mortgages.

To qualify for Habitat For Humanity of Marion County's housing program, applicants must have: (1) Need for quality, affordable housing; (2) Willingness to partner; and (3) Ability to repay a zero percent interest mortgage loan. Families partner with Habitat For Humanity of Marion County by completing a minimum of 300 hours of "sweat equity, complete classes about homeownership and pay a down payment. Candidates are screened for eligibility based on the outlined criteria by a Family Selection Committee made up of volunteers in the community.
